#### What is the Ecodesign Regulation?



Sets emission limits for which products can be commercialized in the EU market

# Lot 15 Solid Fuel Boilers up to 500kW (2020)

Regulation (EU) 2015/1189

## Lot 20 Solid Fuel LSHs up to 50kW (2022)

Regulation (EU) 2015/1185

Limits for both lots will be revised to include stricter requirements on energy efficiency and emissions

Boilers  $\rightarrow$  non-woody biomass and inclusion of products up to 1MW

#### Ecodesign Regulation – ongoing activities



The review was foreseen for January 2022 and January 2024.

→ Both revisions are expected by **Q1 2025** 



EU Commission is working on an impact assessment for the new provisions.

A consultation forum was organised in 2023, another one expected after summer

Bioenergy Europe – in contact with DG ENER to ensure actionable limits

→ key to have Member States support

#### **Energy Labelling for Local Space Heaters**




Energy Labelling provides a ranking for appliances' efficiency and influence consumers' behaviour

Regulation (EU) 2015/1186 in place since 2018

#### Main proposed changes:

- Alignment of calculation methods with Ecodesign
- Extension to electric heaters and heat pumps and possible merger
- Revision (elimination) of the biomass factor (BLF 1,45)
- Inclusion of a secondary scale for air pollutants

Bioenergy Europe strongly advocating AGAINST the merger

### Energy Labelling for Local Space Heaters



Financial incentives are connected to the labelling classes

Adoption of revised legislation: initially planned for Q1 2024

→ Postponed to Q1 2025



Bioenergy Europe is advocating for:

- No Merger, and keep separate labels
- If merged label, a change in the Coefficient of Performance (SCOP)
  - Better competitive advantage for LSHs

Member States have a consultive role → key to engage them
